Background: 135-2024 clause 12.24

7.3.1.21.3 Reliability_Evaluation_Inhibit Object Test

Purpose: To verify that Reliability_Evaluation_Inhibit controls whether or not an object performs the reliability-evaluation process.

The test checks the Event_State in steps 1, 5, 10, and 15. Although the Schedule object has a Reliability property (required), Event_State, and other properties related to intrinsic reporting, exist only, if the object supports intrinsic reporting (135-2024 clause 12.24 - footnotes 2 and 3).

Problem:

This test should be run to verify the functionality of Reliability_Evaluation_Inhibit, but it cannot be run with the current test specifications due to the missing Event_State.

Question:

Should the test be modified so that steps 1, 5, 10, and 15 are executed only, if the object supports intrinsic reporting?

Response:

Yes, steps 1, 5, 10, and 15 can only be executed if the object supports intrinsic reporting. This test can still be run even if the object does not support intrinsic reporting and does not have an Event_State property.
